

Dear Teacher,

Thank you for making a reservation for a **Georgia Textile Adventure** at the Juliette Low Birthplace. We will explore the impact of textiles, particularly cotton, on the history of Georgia and Savannah. Your class will learn about the Gordon family and the technology of the nineteenth century.

We will:

1. explore life in 19th-century Savannah
2. review the importance of textiles in 18th- and 19th-century Georgia
3. practice observation and deduction skills; and
4. discover that things change over time and report some differences and similarities.

For your visit to run as smoothly as possible, please plan to arrive a few minutes early to register. When you check in, we will want to know an exact number of students, staff and other adults with you. Check-in at the ticket desk, at the Oglethorpe Avenue ground floor entrance to the house. We will also request a racial count for statistical purposes. It is important to arrive promptly. However, if you have a transportation delay, please call.

Prior to your arrival, please review the museum rules with everyone in your group. We will go over the rules again, but it is helpful if the students are familiar with the basics. They will be better able to concentrate, learn and enjoy the program if they know the ground rules and their schedule (particularly what the lunch plans are)!
