Laurel Grove Cemetery is a park-like Victorian cemetery where many prominent Savannahians are buried. Here, in the Gordon family plot, is the site of Juliette Low’s grave. Daisy designed the monuments for her parents’ graves.

To get to the cemetery from the Juliette Low Center, go west on Oglethorpe Ave. to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. Turn south (left) on MLK, Jr. Blvd. And continue on to Anderson St., about 18 blocks. Turn right on Anderson—the entrance to Laurel Grove is at the end. Gates are opened at 7:00 AM weekdays, 11:00 AM on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. **Gates are locked at 4:00 PM sharp, so don’t linger!**
