- * Girl Scout Troop Experiences offers **hands-on ways to discover history**. There are a variety of experiences to fit each troop's interest, whether that be art, problem-solving, performance, or history.
- * The official **Birthplace Pin** can only be earned at this museum and is pinned to the front of your uniform.

Travel Tips

Tell businesses you're Girl Scouts!
Many places offer Girl Scout discounts or special programs.

Bring walking shoes. It's not uncommon to walk 2-3 miles a day.

Plan ahead. Many experiences need to be booked months in advance.

Don't forget the beach. Tybee Island is only a 15-minute drive away and is a perfect adventure.

When to Visit

Summer is the most popular time of year for Girl Scouts. It is quite hot, so it's a good time to add a beach trip!

Fall and **Spring** have beautiful weather, often in the 70s. This is the city's high season so book ahead.

Winter is when the city cools down, often in the 40s and 50s.

Trip length varies, but a typical visit lasts between 4-7 days.
