Resources Update

There is now one virtual home for all Girl Scout History Society resources, accessible by anyone, at any time, online. The website currently includes Acquisition Questionnaires and recordings of quarterly meetings, but more resources will be added monthly.

The newly updated GSUSA Acquisitions Questionnaires include separate forms for Archival, Uniform, and Object designations. These forms should be filled out by the donor of the proposed acquisition to get as much information as possible to make acquisition decisions and to record the provenance of collection objects. The completed form should be filed in digital and physical object files. Council history groups are welcome to use these forms with their donors.

The Girl Scout Kodak was based on the Vest Pocket Kodak Model B. This camera was only in production for five years (1929-1934), making it a rare artifact in Girl Scout collections. The size of the camera made it easier to pack for troop adventures, and the Kodak and Girl Scout branding look clean, simple, and cohesive.
